### **SCHOOLBOYS' RUGBY INTERNATIONAL.**

The attendance at Bristol, on Saturday, was estimated at 12,000, including a large contingent of Welsh enthusiasts. The Welsh boys gave a delightful exhibition of football and won easily.

Of the English backs (remarks the Bristol "Times and Mirror") by far and away the best player was Meadows, the Gloucester outside half. Two or three times he tried to get through in clever style, but he, like the three-quarters, had to confine most of his attention to defence, and in this he was excellent.
