GLOUCESTERSHIRE GROUP CHAMPIONS.

Gloucestershire gained a decisive victory over Cornwall at Bristol on Saturday by 2 goals (1p.) 5 tries (23 pts,) to nil, and secured honours in the South-West group of the County Championship. The winners will now meet Middlesex in the semi-final at Twickenham, on February 1st.

The conditions at Bristol were the worst possible, but the home team played brilliant football, Gwyn Davies (Cheltenham) being outstanding at three-quarter. Tries were scored by Davies (two), R. James, F. Wadley, I. C. Bendall and C. Carter, and Boughton converted one and kicked a penalty goal.
