GLOUCESTER LOSE TO MOSELEY.

Gloucester had to call on six reserves to complete the team to go to Moseley last week, and for the second time this season the City lost to the Midlanders. The game was played under terrible conditions, the ground being waterlogged in places, and heavy rain falling throughout.

Moseley were the more adaptable side, and deserved their win by 1 goal 2 tries (11 pts.) to 1 try (3 pts.). Russell scored for Gloucester near the end.

The Final English Trial was decided at Twickenham this afternoon. H. Boughton (Gloucester) was selected full-back for The Rest, and A. G. Cridlan (Oxford University), grandson of Mr. J. J. Cridlan, Maisemore Park, was included in the England team.
