Our Visitors . . .

For their last fifteen-a-side match of the season, the Harlequins have to meet one of the strongest packs in the country and one that includes two Internationals—George Hastings of this season's England XV and Vic Leadbetter, who won his caps for England in 1954 when he was playing for the Edinburgh Wanderers. The Gloucester side is captained by Ieuan Sheen, an extremely dangerous centre three-quarter.

In a season of somewhat mixed success, our visitors have, nevertheless, achieved some notable wins. Out of the thirty-four matches played they have won fourteen, lost the same number and drawn six, scoring 281 points themselves against 251. The wins include an at home and away double against Newport. In addition they have also beaten Coventry, Neath, Cambridge University, Bristol and Northampton.

The Harlequins are without the services of David Marques, John Currie, Phil Davies and Vic Roberts who are playing elsewhere and Jones and Thompson are still on the injured list. Nevertheless they are fielding a strong side which includes four Internationals, among them Guy Stener, the French International, who is playing his first game for the Club on home ground.
