Gloucester Rugby Football Club, whom we welcome to Twickenham today, for once include no Internationals in their team. Nevertheless, they are bringing a strong side and one with a record of considerable success behind them. Their results, up to the 9th October, are: Played 8, Won 6, and Lost 2; Points for 123, Points against 42.

Their recent record has been particularly good, since they have defeated two of the strongest provincial clubs in the country—last Saturday they beat Bedford on their home ground 14 points to 6 and, the previous week, Bristol at Gloucester by 13 points to 6.

Included in their fifteen are P. Ford, who played for the Barbarians last season, M. Booth, an England Trial Cap, and, apart from them, another eleven County Caps. The side also includes a place kicker of no mean talent in G. White who, up to last weekend, has scored 51 points for his Club, though nine of these points were attributable to tries scored by himself.
