

For tonight's game it is our great pleasure to extend a warm welcome to visitors from over the border, Gloucester. Pontypool's last win over Gloucester was at Kingsholm on 29th October 1975, by 19 pts. to 12, and the last home win over them was way back on 16th March 1967, by 19 pts. to 3.
