We extend a warm welcome to Gloucester this evening and look forward to a keen tussle with our old friends from across the Bridge. Gloucester have been involved in a hectic Easter programme with games against Lydney, Broughton Park and Fylde in the space of six days, all of which they won! Last season saw us visit Gloucester to suffer a 15 - 10 defeat with a try from Glyn Davies, now making a name for himself as the Cardiff full-back, and two penalties by Gary Hewlett. Their last two visits to the Welfare Ground have resulted in victories for us by 22 - 9 in 1977 and 15 - 6 in 1976.

Last Saturday saw us gain a fine win over Wakefield by 42 - 4. The whole Newbridge side played well and Chris Phillips' hat-trick of tries was the first since March last year when Chris Walden performed the feat at Hayle. Tony Browning is once again our leading try scorer with 11 followed by Chris Phillips with 7. Justin Robinson is the leading points scorer with 106, closely followed by Tony Browning with 87. It is therefore likely that with five games left we will have two centurions in one season. Would this be the first time for this to happen? Jeff Harris tops the appearance list with 34 out of a possible 35 — 32 of which have been consecutive.
