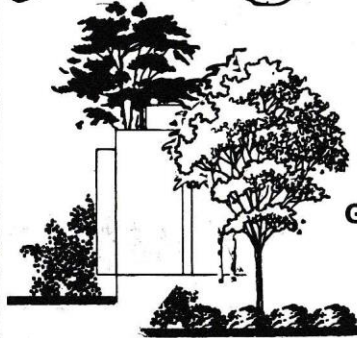

## Profile of today's Referee

**DAVID EURFYL WILLIAMS** was born at Brynamman on the 12th October 1939, and is by profession an Engineering Assistant (Local Government).

His Schools rugby was played for Amman Valley Grammar School, and he had trials at the Under 15 and 19 levels.

He captained the Welsh Youth XV against Germany in 1957/58, and the Brynamman Senior XV in 1959-60. He then went on to play for Swansea, Llanelli, Neath, Aberavon and Maesteg, captaining Carmarthenshire and playing for a Bridgend/Maesteg XV against Canada.

He took up refereeing in 1970, after fracturing his leg in December 1966, whilst playing for Brynamman.

He would like to see the Laws amended to permit handling after a tackle and in rucks, and legalise players helping fellow forwards in the lines-out.

Married, he has two young children—Elinor (13) and Richard (11).

He lists his hobbies to include playing all games, and his special favourites are squash and table tennis.

His best rugby memory was leading out the Welsh Youth XV in 1957-58, and his main ambition—the usual one for referees, to officiate in a game with a major touring side or an International.

Eurfyl says—"I have made a great number of lasting friendships in the game, and particularly enjoy after-match discussions with players, officials and supporters. What I don't like is at times having to referee a side which come out onto the field of play with entirely the wrong attitude".

We wish Eurfyl many more happy years of refereeing, as it is obvious that this ebullient West Walian really enjoys a job which is never an easy one.

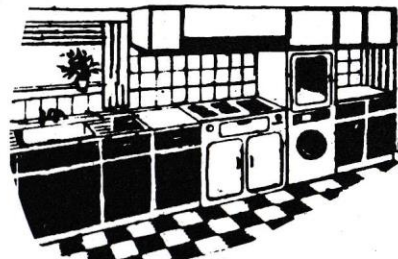
