The Camborne Club is pleased to welcome to the Recreation Ground today the last of the teams which we meet in the South West Merit Table. The mighty Gloucester team provide formidable opposition but despite our lowly standing in the South West Table this season we shall endeavour to give them a game to make them realise that the results in the South West Merit Table belie our true potential. Gloucester, of course, were ejected from the John Player Cup despite having drawn their last round game. A try by the opposition was sufficient to overcome the Butler Boot. Had this not been so they would have been involved today in a John Player semi-final.

Camborne won through to the final of the Cornwall K.O. Cup last Sunday with a 17—7 win over Launceston. Despite being a cup semi-final the game was a marvellous one for the spectators and Camborne proved, with the first try, that they can play 15 man Rugby and play it well. Credit also to Launceston who certainly entered into the spirit and provided a match to remember.

The win on Saturday (and subsequent results of other Merit games) has almost assured us of the Cornwall Merit Table Championship for the fourth successive year, although the less said about the performance against Truro the better. Nonetheless, this has been a creditable season for the Club except when we cross the Tamar.

Someone who does cross the Tamar (and indeed the English Channel) and still win (or at least compete with honour) is young Jonathan Richards. He is a Camborne youngster who has brought great credit to this Town at a very young age. The list of his achievements is far too long to repeat here but he has already represented his Country with great credit, winning most of the long distance races he enters. Last weekend in an International line-up in Madrid he came eleventh but was only 29 seconds behind the winner. The Camborne Club congratulates Jonathan on his successes and hopes that he will have the fortitude to compete with honour for many years to come.

On Thursday next there will be a Veor match on this ground in aid of the Nick Castle charity. Please support this very worthwhile cause.

Next Saturday there will be a heavy programme at the Recreation Ground. The game against Brixham will kick-off at 2.00 p.m. and this will be followed at 5.30 p.m. with the Colts County Championship semi-final between Cornwall and Warwickshire. A licensed refreshment tent will be operating from 3.30 p.m.
