Glamorgan Wanderers v Gloucester

On Wednesday, 18 September 1985 Kick Off 7.15p.m.

This evening we greet Gloucester as our first English visitors to the Memorial Ground this season and hope that the match will be as entertaining as previous encounters.

Gloucester are one of the leading British sides and have been for many years. They have a long history and have produced a long list of internationals who have served their country with distinction. Their most capped player was A. T. Voyce who played 27 times for England and some 34 other players have received caps whilst at the Gloucester club.

This season the Gloucester club have had a difficult start which has not gone as well as usual. They have made one visit to Wales where they lost to Swansea and last Saturday were narrowly defeated by Coventry at home. Nevertheless, this will be a spur for them to get back into winning ways.

The Wanderers have also had a difficult start and can be well pleased with results so far. The performance against Cardiff at home leads club officials to view the season with optimism. Although losing, it needed all the skills of Gareth Davies and Terry Holmes to pull Cardiff through. This was followed by a visit to Aberavon which saw the Wanderers win and therefore chalk up their first Whitbread Merit Table victory. Last Saturday, the club moved into the next stage of the Cup with a comprehensive win at Taffs Well – this now means that the Wanderers get a Home tie in the next round.

Tonight's team is the same one which did duty last Saturday. Next Saturday, the Wanderers are away to Ebbw Vale and this is followed by a Home match against our old rivals, Pontypridd a week tonight – Kick Off 7.15p.m.
