## FOOTBALL

On Saturday last Gloucestershire defeated Cornwall at Camborne, by 2 goals 2 tries to one try. Six Gloucester men (Taylor, P. Stout, Hall, F. Stout, A. Pitt, and Hipwood) were included in the County team, and Hall scored one of the tries. The other points were obtained by Hailing (2) and Parsons. This match was a county championship fixture.

Though weakened by the absence of the players mentioned above, the City club got the better of Clifton, on the latter's ground, winning by 2 goals 1 try (13 points) to 1 try. Click, Clutterbuck, and Rose scored for the winners, and Romans kicked the goals. Beloe notched the try for Clifton, and thus had the honour of crossing the Gloucester lines for the first time this season.
