STRONG U A U SIDE FOR KINGSHOLM EVENING MATCH

Although there are several notable absentees in the Universities Athletic Union's team because of injuries sustained at this week's coaching course at Lilleshall, the side to play Gloucester at Kingsholm on Tuesday (6.15) should maintain the reputation the U A U has for fast open Rugby.

Boyd (Reading), C. Jones (Aberystwyth), K. Baggs (Durham), T. G. Evans (Bangor), C. Holmes (Sheffield), D. Hughes (Aberystwyth), G. B. Myers (Loughborough).

County players are: Chapman (Durham), Staniford (Cheshire and England trial), Brophy (Lancashire), Hill (Staffordshire), and Baggs (Durham).

Impett was called from the coaching course on Wednesday to take part in the Durham "trial," with Chapman as his partner, and is expected to gain a "cap" this year.

An inside-evens sprinter – he is a former Midlands junior champion – Impett is a strong player who should go far.

Boyd, an Ulster schoolboys and Collegians' player, is an excellent hooker and a robust player in the loose.

Baggs and Evans are excellent jumpers in the lines-out, and it will be interesting to see how they fare against the home middle row.
