David Gilbert-Smith, the Scottish international, continues at lock forward for Gloucester, who travel to Aberavon (train 9.40 a.m.) on Saturday.

Apart from this selection the team has a familiar appearance with Alan Holder resuming at full-back after a spell at fly-half in the Moseley game last week and the customary threequarter line unchanged.
