## JEREMY TAYLOR BACK FOR GLOUCESTER

Former Gloucester place-kicker and regular first team centre Jeremy Taylor makes a re-appearance for Gloucester at Kingsholm on Saturday when the Cherry and Whites meet Old Blues.

Taylor has been unable to play regularly for the past two seasons because of business commitments which have taken him away from Gloucester.

Saturday's match will be the second appearance in the premier side for Barry Jackson, the wing threequarter and it will be the third appearance for Mike Nicholls as hooker.

Jackson is in place of Peter Meadows, who travels with the County team as reserve, to Torquay, and Nicholls replaces Mike Wetson, also reserved for the County.
