TAYLOR ON WING; PACK PLACES FOR FOWKE, BRINN

GLO'STER CHANGES FOR 'VARSITY TRIP

Jeremy Taylor, the former Gloucester RFC centre who played several games for the Harlequins after he left Gloucester the season before last, is being tried on the wing for Saturday's away match against Oxford University.

He replaces winger Tony Osman, who travels as reserve. The Club's selectors have decided not to disturb the present centre combination of John Bayliss and Ron Pitt but have felt it necessary to introduce Taylor, a player who built a big reputation with the Club a couple of seasons ago as a kicker, for the place kicks.

Long-time prop for the premier side, Jackie Fowke returns to the front row in place of the man who took his position, Tug Wilson. The RAF and former Gordon League player, Wilson has an international trial next week.

A further change is also announced in the pack. Alan Brinn, who recently received his county cap after three appearances with the North Midlands, returns to the second row in place of county player Roy Long.
