Early today Gloucester club officials were keeping the Oxford team informed of weather conditions at Kingsholm, where the match was to be played.

However, after making a final check with the Gloucester meteorological office, it was decided to telephone the waiting Oxford players with the news.

The match will not now be played and, if Cambridge manage to play all their games before the Varsity match next Tuesday, then Oxford will go to Twickenham with one less match under their belts.
