GLOUCESTER HOPE TO KEEP SAME TEAM FOR BOTH TOUR GAMES

Gary White, the try-scoring star of Gloucester's win over Pontypool on Monday, is included in the premier side's team to meet Redruth – the first match of the end of their season tour.

White retired from play on Monday after dislocating a finger, but after hospital treatment he has declared himself fit for the tour. He was called in originally to replace injured wing forward Dick Smith.

Barring injuries at Redruth, the team will remain unchanged from that which beat Pontypool by 30 points to 8 for Gloucester's match, on the return journey, against Exeter.

There will be 21 playing members of the touring party, but not all will be assured of a game, a club spokesman said today. "The club has a good long run of wins and we must select the strongest side for each game," he said.
