Will Jones

This afternoon we go back half a century to spotlight an Aberavon Captain and Inside Half of the 1909-1914 era. He is Will Jones, now well into his seventies, but still serving the Wizards.

Will Jones retired from his work some years ago, but is still found at the Players' Entrance on match days. He was made a Life Member of the Club for his untiring services in bringing the club back to life after the war years.

Contemporaries of Will in his playing days were David Rees, who is also a Life Member and Dan Tobin. He is proud to recall that he was a member of the Aberavon XV which won the "South Wales Rugby Challenge Cup" in 1913-14 by defeating the Blaina R.F.C. at Bridgend. This was the last occasion on which the cup was played for.

He also played a few games with Swansea, Briton Ferry and Maesteg, playing for the latter club against the Wizards during their period at the Mansel Cricket Ground in Sandfields.
