### COVENTRY MISS THEIR CHANCES

Gloucester held a lead of 5pts. over Coventry at the interval in their game at Coventry this afternoon.

Gloucester went ahead with a try that came following a drive by the forwards. They took play to within a yard of the Coventry line, and BAYLISS went over for an unconverted try.

A brave attempt by Kaye to break through on his own was foiled when the Coventry winger's pass was smothered by two Gloucester backs.

From a free kick Harris kicked short for Coventry.

A classical try by HOOK was the next thrill, the winger scoring after Bown had sent him through. Parker converted.

Just before the interval PURCHASE went over for an un-goaled try for Coventry.
