The duel at half-back will be particularly interesting. R. R. Morris and P. Redwood, the Bristol pair, who played together against Cornwall, have been doing extremely well lately, and should the Gloucester pair outshine them, a place would have to be found for Morris, who is playing too well to be left out of the side.

There is likely to be one or two vacancies in the pack, so the forwards will be closely watched.

Bristol will be out for revenge for Gloucester beat them 11–nil at the Memorial Ground in September.

The kick-off is at 3.0 o'clock, and another large attendance is expected.
