GLO'STER WELL BEATEN

CARDIFF PROVE TOO STRONG

In the opening stages of their game with Cardiff, at Cardiff to-day, Gloucester were rarely out of their own half.

Cardiff pressed continually, and the City line had a narrow escape when Stone dribbled over with Spence well up.

The latter was about to drop on the ball when Meadows dashed up and kicked it dead.

From a punt ahead by Jones the ball travelled to the City line, and in spite of a gallant effort by Parker WILLIAMS picked up and scored easily. Stone converted and Cardiff were five points up.

After a spell of attacking by Gloucester, Cardiff resumed the offensive, and WOOLLER, running with great determination, scored in the corner. He failed to convert.

Half-time :

In the second half Cardiff were again superior, and after a spirited burst by Wooller, EDWARDS scored wide out. Stone failed with the kick.

Although the City attacked occasionally, they were unable to make any impression. There was some loose dribbling on both sides.

SPENCE picked up and had an unopposed run to the line for the fourth time. Stone again failed with the kick.
