### GLO'STER UNCHANGED FOR VISIT TO BEDFORD

Wing threequarter Tony Osman and centre John Bayliss are still unfit, both suffering from bruises, and are not included in the Gloucester XV which travels to Bedford on Saturday.

Osman, heavily bruised in the game with Moseley almost a fortnight ago, will be missing his third consecutive game, while Bayliss, whose shoulder injury in the mid-week floodlit match at Newport dashed his County hopes to a certain extent, will be out for the second Saturday in succession.

And as a result of the two three-quarters being unavailable, the Gloucester side remains the same as that which trounced Bristol at Kingsholm on Saturday.

Taking the places of Osman and Bayliss will be Peter Meadows and Ron Pitt, the two players who filled the breach last Saturday and also turned out for the United at Cinderford last night.

Gloucester United are trying a new fly-half for their game against Pontypool United at Kingsholm on Saturday (kick-off 3.15). David Ainge, a former Cheltenham and Old Centralians player who also plays cricket for the County Police XI links up with scrum-half Gary Mace. Consequently United's regular fly-half Eric Stephens moves to the centre.
