GLO'STER RECALL WETSON AS HOOKER

BRINN MOVES UP FRONT FOR LEICESTER GAME

Mike Wetson, who has been playing in the United side this year, gets his first chance in the Gloucester side as hooker on Saturday when they visit Leicester.

In a somewhat altered line-up after last week's defeat against Coventry with eight reserves fielded, he is joined by John Bayliss, returning from County duty to replace Jeremy Taylor at right centre threequarter. Alan Brinn has been moved into the front row of the scrum to take the place of Fowke, who is not available this week, and Brinn's place in the pack goes to Owen.

The team will be leaving Kingsholm by coach at 10.30 a.m. on Saturday to make the trip to Leicester.

United, at home to Cleve, field a stronger side than they could last week, and Jeremy Taylor returns to the right centre position in the three-quarter line.
