FORD, BOOTH, PITT BACK AGAIN IN GLO'STER XV

Gary White, Gloucester's effervescent back-row forward, is not included in the side to play Bath at Kingsholm tomorrow night (kick-off 6.30 p.m.).

Dave Owen, who turned out against Newbridge on Saturday, retains his place in the back-row. Peter Ford, unable to play on Saturday, is now fit, and will fill his usual wing forward berth. Mick Booth, another player who has been on the injured list, comes back into the side – at the expense of Peter Meadows.

Ron Pitt, yet another absentee, takes over from Graham Wright in the centre, while, in the second row, Roy Long stands down in favour of Brian Hudson. Gloucester's left winger, Bob Smith, also stands down. His place will be taken by Tony Osman.
