### GLOUCESTER'S FOURTH HOME DEFEAT

Gloucester sustained their fourth successive home defeat on Saturday, when the Harlequins gained their first victory at Kingsholm by 1 goal 3 tries (14 points) to 2 goals (10 points). McIlwaine and Brown scored for Gloucester and Millington converted. Both clubs were weakened owing to players being engaged in the International trial at Bath, where the Possibles beat the Probables by 22 points to 14.

For the final trial at Twickenham next Saturday (January 2nd) six Gloucestershire players have been chosen for England v. The Rest – A. T. Voyce and Dr. Taylor (Gloucester), and L. J. Corbett, R. C. Pickles, J. S. Tucker, and M. Shaw (Bristol).

The postponed county championship match Gloucestershire v. Somerset will be played at Kingsholm on Monday (December 28th).
