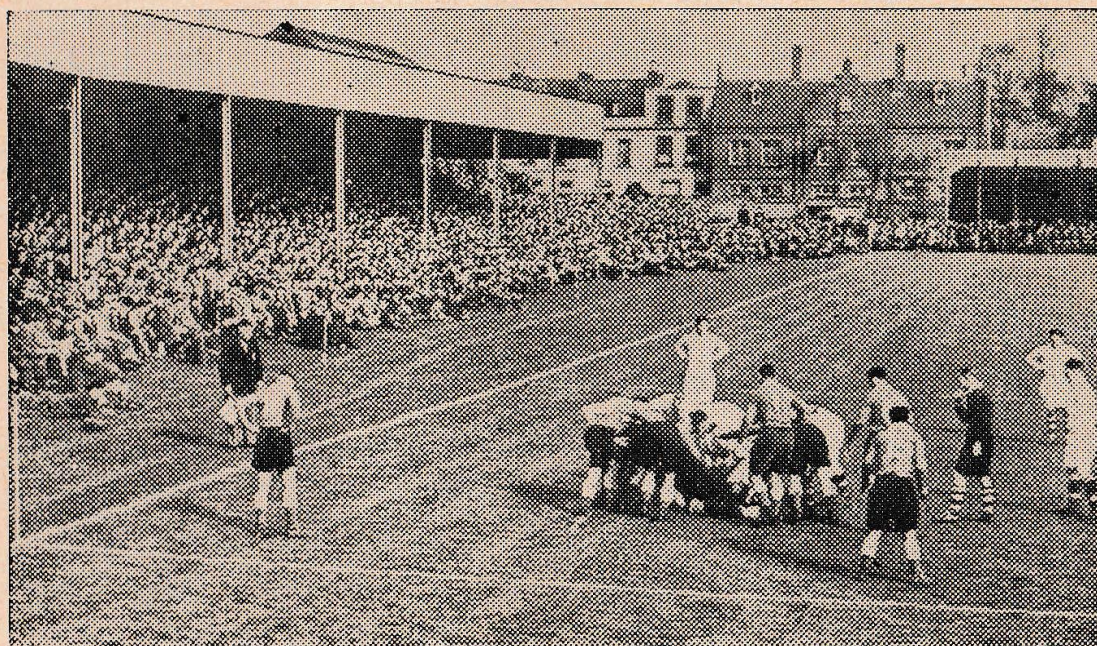

Matches with Coventry have usually been one a season but last year there were two. The match at Coventry was cancelled owing to frost and Gloucester won at Kingsholm 14-0. Gloucester won narrowly in 1945-46 and in 1950-51 by 20-6. The games at Coventry have resulted :—

1946-47	Cancelled owing to frost.
1948-49	Coventry won 5-3.
1949-50	Coventry won 11-0 (transferred from Gloucester owing to International Trial)
1950-51	Cancelled owing to frost.

Coventry have had a successful season losing on two of 16 games played, scoring 203 points to 58.

Roy Parry has a cold and A. Wadley takes his place this being the only change from the team which played against Oxford University.

Hook (Gloucester) and R. F. Batstone (Coventry, forward) are playing in the English Trial to-day.
