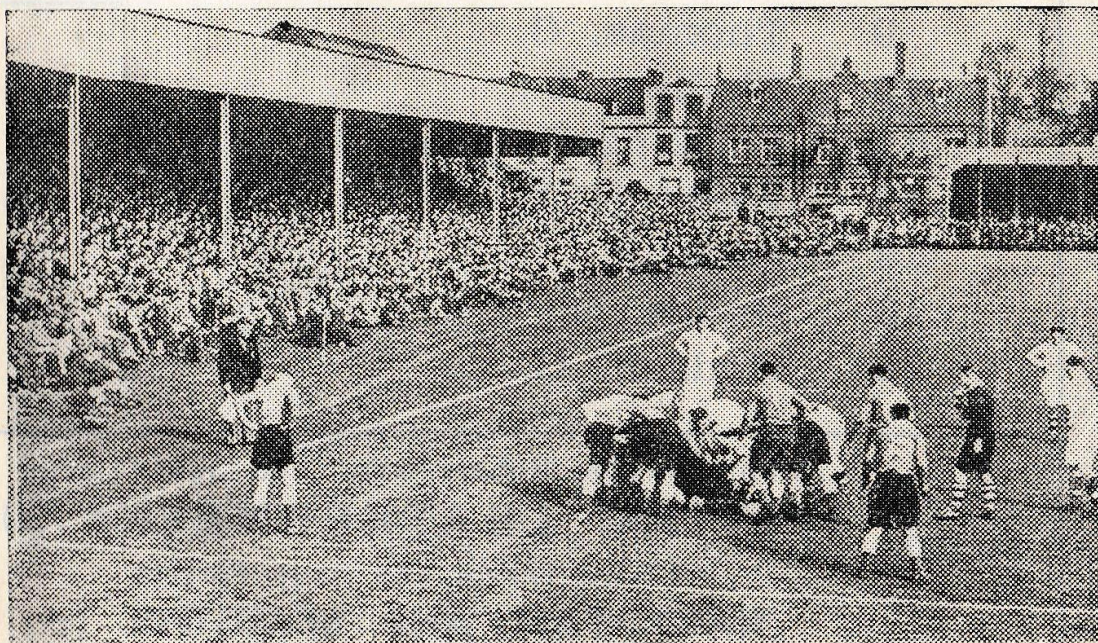

## NOTES

At Portsmouth the Services won in 1947/8 by 20—8, while Gloucester won there 6—3 in 1949/50. Last year the match was transferred to Portsmouth owing to a County Semi-Final at Gloucester, and was drawn 0—0.

This season the Services have won against their Devonport rivals and their record to date is :—P 22, W 8, D 1, L 13. Points 234—265.
