## FOOTBALL

Gloucester had Moseley for opponents at Kingsholm on Saturday, the City winning by 1 goal (d), 3 tries (13 points) to 1 goal, 1 try (8 points). Gloucester did all their scoring in the first half, when Loveridge (2) and Foulkes obtained tries and Millington dropped a goal. Some delightful football was witnessed during this period, but there was a complete transformation after the change of ends, both teams displaying disappointing form. Moseley had a weak side out and did well to run the City to a five points margin.

On Tuesday (Barton Fair Day) Cinderford were visitors. The City played several reserves, but in a free scoring match won by 23 points to 15. Gloucester scored 1 goal, 6 tries, whilst Cinderford's points were made up of 1 converted goal, two penalty goals, and one dropped goal.

Several Gloucester players are on the injured list including the captain and vice-captain (Voyce and Loveridge), Millington, and Thomas. Crowther, too, was off the field against Moseley, and did not play against Cinderford.
