FOOTBALL.

GLOUCESTER SCORE FREELY AT HEREFORD.

Gloucester played Hereford on the latter's ground on Thursday night, before an attendance of 2,000, and had a good match, the City winning comfortably by 48 points to 11. Tries for the City were scored by J. Stephens (3), P. C. Hyam, Lydney (3), Roy James (4), and W. Hart, Cheltenham. H. Boughton converted two tries, Hyam two, and James two, the latter also dropping a goal from a mark.

The City's score was made up of 7 goals (1m) and 5 tries. L. E. Saxby got a try for Hereford, for whom Yorath, a forward, also scored two tries, W. C. Powell, the Welsh International, converting one. Gloucester led at half-time by 22-11.

The City forwards heeled in splendid style, and Roy James was conspicuous in much of the combination by the Gloucester backs.
