V. DAVIES IN SWANSEA'S FIFTEEN

Former Gloucester scrum-half Vivian Davies will be playing for Swansea against the Cherry and Whites at St. Helen's to-morrow.

His outside-half partner will be the Welsh trialist, Glyn John.

Swansea are not able to call on the services of Bryan Jenkins, who is on the injured list, but two former "casualties," Bernard Hedges and Ken Richards will be back in the team.

The Swansea team will be chosen from :

Bernard Hedges; H. Phillips; K. Richards, A. N. Other, Teifon Williams, T. Frame; Glyn John, Vivian Davies; Doug. Jones, T. Petherbridge, H. V. Payne, J. Rees, G. Evans, L. Blyth, Owen Hughes, W. D. Johnston.

Swansea's playing record this season is much the same as Gloucester's, though the Cherry and Whites have scored considerably more points in fewer games.

The records of the two clubs are as follows: Swansea, won 15, drawn 3, lost 9, points 199, against 172; Gloucester: won 14, drawn 2, lost 9, points 266, against 191.

No changes in the Gloucester fifteen had been reported up to to-day.
