NEWPORT TO PLAY LEWIS IN CENTRE

Newport will be without three of their "stars" when they play their return fixture with Gloucester at Kingsholm tomorrow (3.15).

Wing-threequarter Ken Jones will be playing for Wales against France, and outside-half Roy Burnett and centre-threequarter Malcolm Thomas are due to travel to Paris as reserves.

Dennis Price comes in as full-back so that Malcolm Lewis can move up to one of the centre positions.

John Wills will be their centre, and Dick Sheppard moves out to the wing.
