## RUNAWAY UNITED WIN

GLOUCESTER UTD. 50 Pts., CHELTENHAM UTD. NIL

Gloucester United ran in 10 tries to overwhelm Cheltenham with attacking open football at Kingsholm last night.

Winning an endless stream of possession, Gloucester mounted strong pressure on the Cheltenham line, but six of the tries were scored by forwards.

The scoring started after 10 minutes when scrum-half Marcus Hannaford crossed for a try which Roger Fowke converted.

Richard Pascall and flanker Ray Wood added tries one of which Fowke converted to give United a 16-0 lead at half-time.

In the second half, Cheltenham were again unable to contain Gloucester and tries came at regular intervals from Hannaford (2), Wood (2) – both completing their hat-tricks – Pascall, Jeremy Bennett and Pdraig Conway. Fowke kicked three conversions.
