GLOUCESTER TEST SMITH AT ORRELL

Gloucester have recalled full-back Tim Smith for their testing at Orrell tomorrow. Smith lost his place to Paul Webb early in the New Year and has since been playing on the wing for the United. Now an injury to Webb gives him an opportunity to challenge once again for a regular place.

Backs Derek Morgan and Richard Mogg both return to the side following injuries. Morgan replaces Jim Breeze and Mogg renews his partnership with Paul Taylor at the expense of Cormack O'Donaghue.

Hooker Kevin White and prop Richard Pascall again stand in for Steve Mills and Phil Blakeway, both on international duty, while John Fidler is not available and is replaced by John Brain. Flu' victim Mike Teague misses the match and is replaced by Larry Cummins.

Gloucester United have no game tomorrow, but entertain Luctonians at Kingsholm on Monday evening.
