Of course, we would like to extend a huge thank you to Gloucester for hosting today's


Finally, I hope that you enjoy the Mitsubishi Motors Hybrid Cup as much as we will. I'll do my best to get the game off to a good start

A true fans favourite for the Cherry and Whites. Ludo was a key part of the Gloucester backline as soon as he arrived from Aurillac in 2001, scoring a massive 592 points in his first spell with

Ludo spent a season apiece with Grenoble and Pau before returning to the Cherry and Whites in 2005, adding another 263 points to his evergrowing haul.

In fact, many of the points went sailing through Philippe Saint-Andre's specially adapted goalposts, which were extended due to Ludo's tendency to kick high and handsome when aiming at goal.

LESLEY VAINIKOLO

The Volcano is back at Kingsholm! The dual-code star made a huge impact at Kingsholm during his career in Cherry and White, and will need no introduction to the home crowd

The Tongan born wrecking ball started his career in Rugby League for the Canberra Raiders, before breaking countless records in 152 appearances for the Bradford Bulls. This caught Gloucester's attention and five tries on debut caught the rugby union world's attention!


Also represented England at Rugby Union before Lesley headed over the Channel to join La Rochelle, and now lives in New Zealand. For one week only Lesley is back!

Mike Tindall may have married into the British Royal Family, but Olivier Azam is surely Gloucester Rugby Royalty!


The duo were back at Kingsholm a short time ago to catch up, and try out the special Gloucester Rugby Heroes jersey for size.
