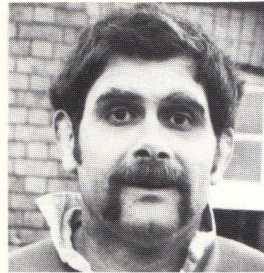

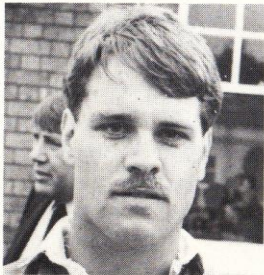
Peter Wickenden Age 25 Fullback

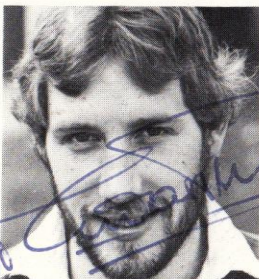
Derrick Morgan Age 24 Winger

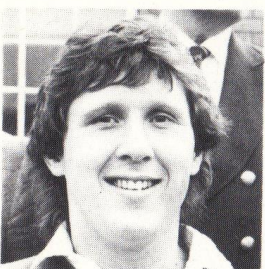
Tim Ford **Age 23** **Winger**

Tim joined Gloucester this season whilst in the R.A.F. and so earned himself the title of the flying winger. However, he has now left the force and now figures as a civil servant.



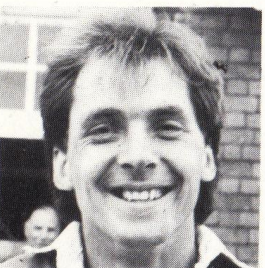
Simon Long **Age 25** **Winger**

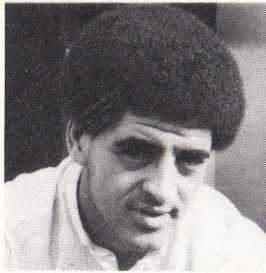
Paul Taylor **Age 29** **Centre**

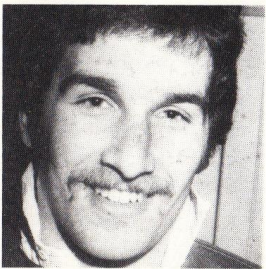

Marcus Hannaford Age 23 Scrum Half

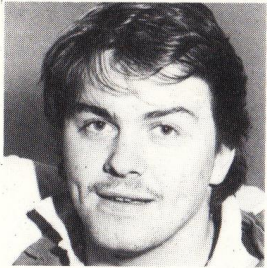
Marcus joins the tour a bit late due to England 'B' commitments in Italy. He is a very inventive player and erects fences, amongst other things, for a living.

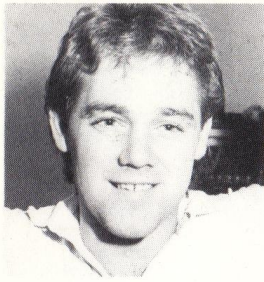
Rob Phillips Age 27 Prop

Glyn Mann Age 23 Hooker

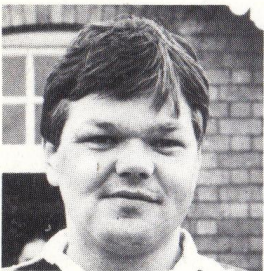

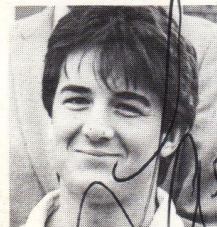
Dave Spencer Age 27 Flanker / No.8
