### GLOUCESTER DEFEATED AT LLANELLY

The Gloucester team stayed over the week-end at Swansea in order to fulfil the return match with Llanelly on Monday, in lieu of the fixture postponed on December 18, owing to frost. Fred Webb, the City captain, had to return home on Saturday night, and his place at centre was filled by D. Flynn, of the Swansea club. Otherwise the Gloucester Fifteen was the same as suffered defeat by 16 points to nil at Swansea, on Saturday.
