GLOUCESTERSHIRE BEATEN BADLY

Gloucestershire suffered a heavy defeat from Devon at Exeter by 4 goals 2 tries (26 pts.) to 1 goal 2 tries (11 pts.). At half-time the score was 8 pts. to 6 in favour of Devon. Burland, McCanlis, and Dowling scored for Gloucester[sic], who were outplayed in the second half.

At Kingsholm a weak Gloucester team proved successful over the U.C.S. Old Boys by 15 points to 8.

The South Africans, continuing their victorious tour, beat Durham and Northumberland on Saturday by 41 pts. to nil, and Glasgow on Wednesday by 21 pts. to 13.
