At Kingsholm, on Saturday, Gloucester gained a decisive victory over Bath by 1 goal (p), 6 tries (21 points) to nil. The match was played under wretched conditions but the City backs gave their best display of the season and Brown (2), Hughes (2), Taylor and Hemmings scored tries; all the place kicks failing.

Millington, however, was more successful with a penalty shot.

The New Zealanders met a London XV, at Blackheath and won easily by 28 points to 3. To-day the All Blacks were engaged in the final match of the tour against England at Twickenham. A. T. Voyce (Gloucester), and L. J. Corbett and J. S. Tucker (Bristol) were included in the England Fifteen. The tourists were fully expected to retain their unbeaten record.
