GLOUCESTER 8 Points; COVENTRY 3

### CORRECTED RESULT

The correct result of the Gloucester-Coventry match on Saturday was: Gloucester 2 goals (1 p) (8 pts.); Coventry 1 try (3 pts.), and not 5 pts. to 3 in favour of the City as given in Saturday's Football "Citizen."

The mistake arose owing to a misapprehension as to Tom Voyce's penalty kick for goal.

"I was under the impression (writes W.B.) that the shot was unsuccessful, and remained in my ignorance of the fact that a goal had been scored until after the team's arrival home, and the players saw the result in the Football "Citizen."

On the play Gloucester deserved to win by a larger margin. The City did far more attacking, but lost several fine openings at the critical moment. Besides the penalty goal kicked by Voyce, Crowther scored a try for Gloucester which the captain converted, and Grubb obtained an unconverted try for Coventry, after a clever movement by Pemberton.
