GLOUCESTER'S HANDSOME WIN

Plymouth Albion, minus the services of their three International forwards (Hanley, Sparkes and Stanbury) were well beaten by Gloucester at Kingsholm by 22 points to 3.

Tries were scored for the City by J. Stephens, Foulkes, Wadley, and Hough (2), Boughton converting two and also kicking a penalty goal from near half-way. The Gloucester backs again showed good form.

At Dublin, England defeated Ireland by 1 goal (d.) 1 try (7 points) to 2 tries (6 points). J. V. Richardson, the old Oxford Blue, did all the scoring for England.
