GLOUCESTER'S GREAT PERFORMANCE

Gloucester put up their best performance of the season last Saturday when they drew with Newport 19 points each. It was a thrilling game, the feature being the remarkable recovery of the City team in the second half.

Newport were at one period leading by 19 points to 6, but Gloucester made a great rally, and scoring three tries (two converted) equalised the scores in the last two minutes.

Previous to Saturday Gloucester had not escaped defeat at Newport since December 8th, 1900, when the score was one try each.
