Newport Rugby Club will be without both their regular centres when they meet Gloucester at Rodney Parade tomorrow (3.30).

Their latest casualty is Brian Jones, who broke a bone in his arm while playing against Blackheath last Saturday.

Apart from this, however, the Usksiders will have a strong side in the field.

The team includes D. O. Brace and Roy Burnett – one of the most dangerous half-back combinations in Britain – and the wingers will be international Olympic Games sprinter Ken Jones, and John Lane.
