IRELAND MAN IN COVENTRY FIFTEEN

Coventry will be without right wing threequarter Peter Jackson and wing forward Ray Batstone when they meet Gloucester at Kingsholm tomorrow (3.0).

Jackson has not yet recovered from a knee injury received when playing for Warwickshire against Leicestershire last week and Batstone is kept out because of a broken nose.

Former Irish international Niall Bailey, who joined Coventry from Northampton at the beginning of the season, continues as Jackson's deputy and John Bluck does duty for Batstone.

The former England captain Ivor Preece will lead Coventry Extra Firsts who entertain Gloucester United.
