GLO'STER PICK MORGAN FOR THE CENTRE

While Gloucestershire tackle Somerset at Kingsholm on Saturday, Gloucester face yet another away match – this time with Moseley at the Reddings.

With six players in the county side the Red and Whites again have to call on reserves.

Derek Morgan, who has had several good games for United, is brought into the centre, while Howard Terrington will fill the outside half position.

Mervyn Burford comes in as hooker and the other vacancy in the front row of the pack will be filled by J. Herbert. The wing forward berths will be filled by Glyn Williams, former Welsh international reservist, and M. C. Jones.

Early this season Gloucester routed a below-strength Moseley side at Kingsholm by 32 points to five.

When Gloucester last visited Moseley a year ago – also on a county match day – the Red and Whites gained a narrow victory by one dropped goal to nil.
