'QUINS BRING SIX "CAPS" TO KINGSHOLM

Harlequins will have one of their strongest sides in the field when they tackle Gloucester at Kingsholm tomorrow (3.15).

The visitors, who have been having a good season, are bringing no fewer than six internationals as well as a number of trialists. Three of their "caps" – W. P. C. Davies, M. L. Grant and C. G. Woodruff – are in the three-quarter line. Woodruff, who plays on the right wing, has also, of course, appeared for Cheltenham and Gloucestershire.

Nigel Gibbs will be at full back, and the internationals in the pack are J. O. Sanders, and Cornwall's Vic Roberts. Another Gloucestershire player, R. A. M. Whyte is also included in the pack.

Harlequins play a fast, open game and given good weather the game should be an exciting one.
