Gloucester United defeated Cheltenham United 13-9 in an untidy rugby match last night.

Number eight Dave Spencer plus locks Dave Watling and Dick Burn showed up well for Gloucester, while behind the forwards acting skipper Steve Parsloe and centre Russ Ellis were the pick.

Full-back Peter Wickenden gave Gloucester an early lead with a penalty, but Cheltenham led 6-3 at half-time after scoring two penalties through Paul Kemmett.

Spencer burst over to put Gloucester back in front following a tap penalty and Wickenden converted. Soon after lock Burn made a strong run and sent winger Paul Tunstall off on a 40 yard run from which he completed Gloucester's tally.

Cheltenham completed the scoring with a Kemmett penalty.
