GLOUCESTER UTD. 46 Pts., GLAMORGAN WANDERERS A 6 Pts.

United raced to another big rugby win at the expense of their Welsh visitors at Kingsholm last night.

Well served by their forwards, where props Derek Hiam (All Blues) and Dave Evans (Saintbridge FP) combined well with hooker Glyn Mann to win the scrums.

Former Gloucester scrum-half Peter Kingston turned out and showed his old skills at the base.

United took the lead with a try by full-back Paul Ford and another by winger Jim Breeze. Ford converted both and kicked a penalty.

They went further ahead with tries by flanker Dave Spencer and centre Clive Banks. Ford converted one to give United a 25-0 half-time lead.

In the second half, Breeze scored his second try with lock Nigel Scrivens, skipper Paul Wood and winger Keith Powell also going over.

Ford included a penalty and a conversion to take his tally to 18 points.
