## MILLS, GADD STILL UNFIT

Gloucester make another wholesale reconstruction of their team to face Broughton Park at Kingsholm on Saturday (3 pm) with 10 changes from the side that beat Cheltenham last night.

But still missing from the line-up are Steve Mills and John Gadd, who have not recovered from injuries which kept them out of the County game last week, while winger Nick Price is unavailable.

Richard Mogg makes his comeback after a long lay-off with an appearance for Gloucester United in their away match against Newport HSOB. Alongside him in the centre will be airman Russ Huxtable who has completed a term of suspension after being sent off in an RAF match.

Former Gordon League flanker Andrew Stanley makes his fourth appearance in a United team that has yet to be beaten.
