
EXTENDED FAMILIES: The <u>MORGAN</u>, <u>HATHERALL</u> and <u>MANLEY</u> Greater Family: The relationships based on marriage between the families of the grandfather and grandsons <u>Lewis Frederick Morgan</u> and <u>Lewis</u> <u>Stanley George Morgan</u> and the latter's great uncle <u>Thomas ('Tom') Hatherall</u>.



The **MORGAN** Family – Grandfather and grandson <u>Lewis Frederick Morgan</u> and <u>Lewis Stanley George</u> <u>Morgan</u>

Lewis Frederick Morgan was born in Gloucester in 1879, the son of James Morgan (1834-1902), a Labourer, and Emma Morgan (née Price) (1844-1919). The couple had married in Emma's home town of Hereford in 1873 and had three children but only Lewis survived to adulthood. The family lived in Robin Hood Street, Gloucester. On 22 December 1900 Lewis married Elizabeth Sharpe at St. James' Church, Gloucester. The couple initially lived at Barton Terrace while Lewis was employed as a Labourer. The couple had three children, two of whom died in infancy. The remaining child William James Morgan (1903-1984) was the father of <u>Lewis Stanley George Morgan</u>; the latter was therefore the grandson of Lewis Frederick Morgan. By 1901 Lewis had changed his occupation to become a Wagon Repairer and the family moved initially to Finnister Court and then to Forresters Yard, Gloucester. Lewis, half back, played 35 games for the Gloucester First XV between 1899 and 1903, scoring 2 tries. He also represented the Second XV in 35 games between 1899 and 1904, scoring 7 tries. Lewis, whist living in Clifton Road, died at Gloucester in March 1915 aged 35 years from Tuberculosis which he had been suffering with for two years although he continued to work up until a fortnight before his death. His wife, Elizabeth, re-married William Rudman in 1918 and she had two further children; she died in Gloucester in 1941 aged 60 years.

Lewis Stanley George Morgan was born in Gloucester on 9 December 1931, the son of William James Morgan (1903-1984) and Ruth Mary Morgan (née Hatherall) (1908-1989). The couple had married on 26 December 1927 at St. Catharine's Church, Gloucester, and had three children. Lewis' father was the son of Lewis Frederick Morgan who was therefore Lewis' grandfather; Lewis did not know his grandfather who had died sixteen years before he was born. Lewis' mother, Ruth, was the daughter of John Hatherall and Sarah Hatherall (née Spackman); John Hatherall was the brother of Thomas (Tom') Hatherall and hence the latter was the great uncle of Lewis Stanley George Morgan. By 1939 the family were living in Deans Way, Gloucester where Lewis' father worked as a Slate Sander and his mother as a Jam Factory Hand. Also living in the house was Lewis' maternal grandmother, Sarah Hatherall (née Spackman), who had remarried in 1916 to William Whitworth following the death of her husband in 1910; William subsequently died in 1922 after serving in the Great War with the Gloucestershire Regiment. Sarah and William had two children who were Lewis' mother's half-sisters. One of the half-sisters, Gwendoline Gladys Whitworth married Victor Edward Manley whose great uncle George Manley was the father of Harry Benjamin Manley. In 1956 Lewis married Mary Jean Mayo and by 1974 the couple were living in Penhill Road, Gloucester. Lewis, a fly-half and centre, played 42 games for the Gloucester First XV between 1953 and 1955, scoring 4 tries and kicking 8 conversions, 5 penalties and 5 drop goals. He also represented the Second XV in 20 games between 1952 and 1956 scoring 1 try and kicking 5 conversions, 6 penalties and 10 drop goals. Lewis died in Gloucester in December 1986 aged 55 years.
