Fog, which hung over the city all day, descended so heavily half-way through the game that the white ball was used for the first time in the club's history in a home match. But even the white ball could not pierce the gloom sufficiently to follow play throughout. A deep-throated roar, rising to crescendo, was the only indication that Gloucester were pounding away at the visitors' line on the opposite side of the ground. And when Michael Baker landed his second penalty goal – a magnificent kick – the referee had to consult the linesman before allowing the points.</p>
